### Bachelor of Digital Media Degree (All Majors)

#### Tuition Fees

**Indicative Annual Tuition Fee** \$13 700

**Indicative Total Program Tuition Fee** \$27 400

Tuition fees are based on 12 units of study per year, over two years. The 2007 fee is \$1 141.67 per unit. Fees are indicative as unit price is subject to annual adjustment.

Note: Film Major students are required to pay an additional refundable Equipment Security Bond of \$500 on commencement.

#### Payment Options

##### 1 FEE-HELP

Deferred payment arrangements offered to eligible students similar to HECS-HELP. Students apply for a loan from the Commonwealth Government to cover part or all of their tuition fees, and defer repayment of the loan (CPI linked) via the Australian Tax system, until their income reaches the minimum payment threshold.

To apply, contact SAE Byron Bay and ask for the 'Request for FEE-HELP assistance form' and a copy of the 'FEE-HELP information' booklet.

Tuition fees paid through FEE-HELP are processed on the census date of each trimester. Census dates are published on our website.

Note: New Zealand citizens are not eligible for FEE-HELP. Further information on eligibility is available from the FEE-HELP Information Booklet.

Note: A disincentive fee may occur for early withdrawal before the census date. (Maximum of \$250 per unit)

##### 2 Advance or Yearly

Payable in annual instalments, due one month prior to the commencement of each year. The 2007 annual instalments are \$13 700 each. \$500 of this tuition fee must be paid on initial registration.

##### 3 Payment Plan

Payable in 3 equal instalments per year of study, due one month prior to the commencement of each trimester. The 2007 instalments are \$4 566.67 each. \$500 of the first tuition instalment fee must be paid on initial registration.

### Certificate Program (Electronic Music Production)

**Total Program Tuition Fee** \$3 950

Payable in total one month before commencement. \$500 of this tuition fee must be paid on initial registration.

## Additional Costs

### 1. Accommodation

### 2. Study Materials

Students are provided a quota of free photocopying and printing. Once quota has been exhausted, fees may apply.

### 4. Study Resources

SAE provides students with a set of study resources that are essential for the completion of the course. These resources vary between intakes and between streams, due to changes in technology and course requirements.

The provided resources currently consist of:

- Core text books and readings necessary for the program
- External HDD for data backup and storage \*
- Quota of photocopies
- Quota of computer printouts
- Other study resources determined at course commencement

Note : External HDD only provided at the start of the first year that you study at SAE. Students will retain this drive for use in each subsequent year of study.

Note : These resources are subject to change.

### 5. Optional Study Resources

In addition to the resources that SAE provides, individual students may require one or more of the following, according to individual choice:

- Additional text books, magazine subscriptions, on-line memberships or access to other information resources (such as an internet connection at home).
- Additional computing resources, such as a laptop or desktop computer at home.
- Additional electronic devices and secondary storage media (CD-R, DVD) for the backup, and storage, of computer files, audio and video data.
- Internet access fee (if requested in student accommodation).
