OUTLINE OF PAYMENT OPTIONS

FEE-HELP & VET FEE-HELP

Domestic students that meet the requirements outlined in the FEE-HELP or VET FEE-HELP information booklet, may choose to defer their tuition fees through the Commonwealth government FEE-HELP or VET FEE-HELP loan scheme. Fees are processed on the census date of each trimester, based on the HE unit or VET unit price at time of study. Students can apply for FEE-HELP or VET FEE-HELP assistance with their campus. For further details see FEE-HELP or VET FEE-HELP Information Booklet.

Total Course in Advance

International

The 1st Trimester of the tuition fees and the health insurance must be paid on initial registration. The remainder of the total course fees are paid 30 days prior to the commencement of the 1st Trimester. Students paying the total course fee for 2 years of study in advance will receive a 12% discount on the tuition fees.

One Year in Advance

International

The 1st Trimester of the tuition fees and the health insurance must be paid on initial registration. The remainder of the tuition fees are paid 30 days prior to the commencement of each year. Students paying the yearly fees for 1 study year in advance will receive a 6% discount on the tuition fees.

Trimester Installments

Domestic

Unless through the FEE-HELP or VET FEE-HELP scheme, tuition fees are paid in installments at the beginning of each Trimester, with the first payment due on the course commencement day.

International

The 1st Trimester of the tuition fees and the health insurance must be paid on initial registration. All further tuition fees are paid in installments at the beginning of each Trimester.

ADDITIONAL COSTS FOR ALL COURSES OFFERED AT SAE (NOT COMPULSORY)

Study Resources

In addition to the resources that SAE provides, individual students may require one or more of the following. These items may be available for purchase from SAE.

- CD-R, DVD, audio tapes, DV tapes, writing materials, submission folders, etc.
- Additional text books, magazine subscriptions, on-line memberships or access to other information resources.
- Additional electronic devices and secondary storage media (CD-R, DVD-R, external hard drive, etc) for backup and storage of computer files including audio and video data.
